

Website Terms and Conditions of Use Relating to IAMYOGI VIRTUAL Limited.

These Terms and Conditions (“the Terms and Conditions”) govern your (“the User”) use of the IAMYOGI VIRTUAL Limited (“Provider”) website located at the domain name www.iamyogi.co.uk (“the Website”). By accessing and using the Website, the User agrees to be bound by the Terms and Conditions set out in this legal notice.
